



## **Endodontic over-engineering? Why less is more in the management of large periapical lesions.**

### **Course highlights:**

In the pursuit of perfection, modern endodontic often veers into the danger of over-engineering—relying excessively on complex techniques, and “magic bullet” materials. While technological advancements have enriched our toolbox, their indiscriminate use in managing endodontic pathologies has also led to a trend of over-engineering, where complexity may overshadow clinical workflow and biological rationale. This lecture challenges current trends and explores a biology-driven approach that emphasizes the healing potential of periapical tissues. Drawing from clinical experience, current literature, and extensive case-based evidence, the session will discuss the foundational principles of endodontic therapy required for managing cases with large periapical lesions. In an age where more is often equated with better, this session invites everyone to pause and reconsider: Could “doing less” actually be the smartest, most biologically sound treatment choice to achieve predictable healing?
